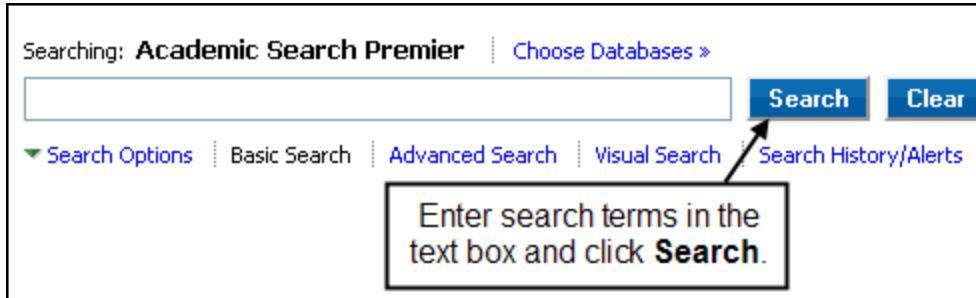




BASIC SEARCH

Basic Keyword Search searches for the entire keyword anywhere in the citation, including:

- Titles
- Author
- Subject
- Abstract



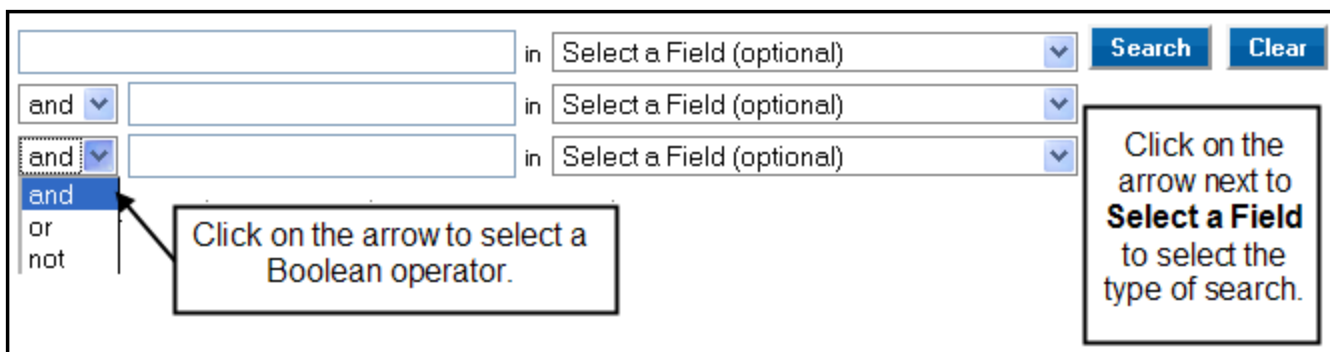
Basic Keyword searches may be made very specific by:

- Using Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT).
- Using truncation and wildcards indicated by an asterisk (*).
- Using proximity operators (N,W,).

ADVANCED SEARCH

Advanced Search combines up to three different search words using Boolean Searching and allows users to choose which specific field (author, title, subject, abstract, or journal name) will be searched.

- Click on Advanced Search.
- Enter each search term in a separate box and click **Search**.



LIMIT YOUR RESULTS

Searches may be limited in a variety of ways either before you begin your search, or by selecting **Search Options** located to the right after your initial search. Available limits depend on which database is being searched.

Limits common to all EBSCOhost databases include:

- Publication
- Published Date
- Full Text.

NARROW YOUR RESULTS

To narrow results by **subject**, click on a narrowed subject heading to the left of the search results.

To narrow results by **source type**, click on the source type to the left of the search results. Source types include:

- Academic Journals
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Books/Monographs

WORKING WITH SEARCH RESULTS

Search results are returned in a list showing:

- Article Title
- Author
- Source
- Published Date

TO CREATE A LIST OF CITATIONS

- Click the folder below each record, or click the folder icon while viewing the full citation.
- To view the folder contents, click on **Folder View** to the right of search results.

TO WORK WITH RESULTS LATER

- Click on the **Envelope** icon in EBSCOhost and enter your e-mail address in the form.
- Click on the **Disk** icon in EBSCOhost and follow the directions to save to your personal computer or USB drive.
- Click on the **Printer** icon in EBSCOhost, click **Print**, and the **OK** in the Print box.
- For PDF Full Text, click on **Save** or **Print** in the Adobe® toolbar.

OBTAINING ARTICLES NOT IN FULL TEXT

- Click on Check SFX for full text OR use **Journals/E-Journals** on the Library website to search at the Jessie C. Eury Library for a specific publication in print or find full text in another database.
 - If Jessie C. Eury Library does not have the article, click on **Interlibrary Loan** and fill out the online Interlibrary Loan Request form—Articles.
- ⇒ Allow at least 3-5 days for article requests to arrive at the Jessie C. Eury Library.
