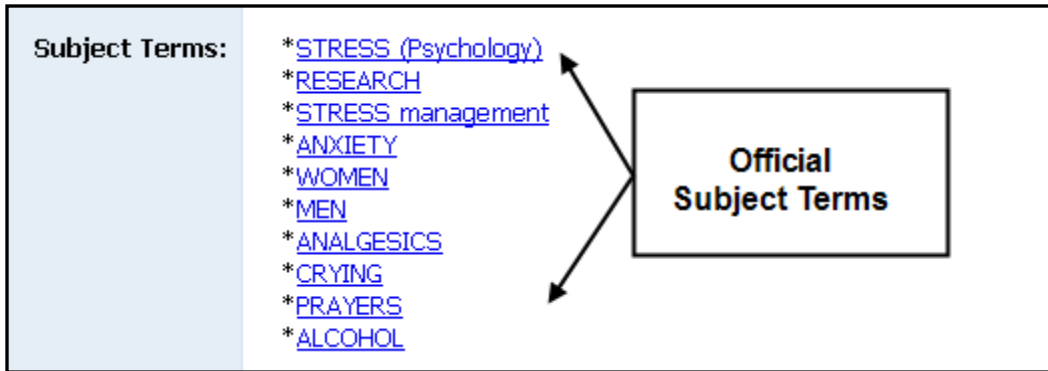




Use Subjects in EBSCOhost

WHY USE SUBJECTS?

- Articles are indexed by authorized Subject Terms.
- Using Subject Terms helps your searches to be more focused and specific than a keyword search.



WHERE DO YOU FIND SUBJECTS?

- **Subject Terms** browses the list of authorized subject terms for the entered words.
- Click in the circle next to:

- ◆ **Term Begins With** to view an alphabetical list of subject terms.
- ◆ **Term Contains** to view a list of subject term containing the entered term.
- ◆ **Relevancy Ranked** to view a list of relevant subject terms.

Enter a term in the text box and click **Browse**.

Click in a square and click **Add**. Then click **Search**.

Click on a term to view broader and narrower terms.

COMBINING SUBJECT HEADINGS

- Using **Advanced Search** a subject term may be combined with other search terms or subject terms to narrow the search.
- Click on **Advanced Search** in the EBSCOhost toolbar.

Enter a specific subject term found using Subject Search or in a citation in the **Find:** box. Enter a second subject term or other keywords in the remaining text box and click **Search**.

Click on the arrow next to AND to select a Boolean operator (AND, OR, NOT) to combine the search

Click on the arrow next to Select a Field to select **Subject Terms**.

WORKING WITH SEARCH RESULTS

Search results are returned in a list showing:

- Article Title
 - Author
 - Source
 - Published Date
- ⇒ Click article title to view the full citation or click **HTML** or **PDF Full Text** to view article.

TO CREATE A LIST OF CITATIONS

- Click the folder to the right of each record or click **Add to Folder** while viewing the full citation.
- To view the folder contents, click on **Folder has item(s)**.

TO WORK WITH RESULTS LATER

- Click on **E-mail** in EBSCOhost and enter your e-mail address in the form.
- Click on **Save** in EBSCOhost and follow the directions to save to your personal computer or USB drive.
- Click on **Print** in EBSCOhost, click **Print** on the form, and **OK** in the Print box.
- For PDF Full Text, click on **Save** or **Print** in the Adobe® toolbar.

OBTAINING ARTICLES NOT IN FULL TEXT

- Click on **Check SFX for full text** OR use **Journals/ E-Journals** on the Library website to search the Jessie C. Eury Library for a specific publication in print or in full text in another database.
 - If Jessie C. Eury Library does not have the article, click on **Interlibrary Loan** and fill out the online Interlibrary Loan Request form—Articles.
- ⇒ Allow at least 3-5 days for article requests to arrive at the Jessie C. Eury Library.
