**GIRLS' BASKETBALL - JUNE 24-27**

Our four-day basketball camp for girls in grades 5-12 will help work on all aspects of the game! From passing to ball-handling, rebounding to defense, shooting to 1-on-1 moves, each player will work on each facet of her game. Players will be grouped by their abilities for team competition, and all players will play an equal amount of game time. Camp is a great way to improve your skills and make tons of new friends. Not only will you improve as a player, but you'll create friendships for a lifetime when you play, pray, and learn the game of basketball with other Christian girls.

**LAUGHLIN CENTER**

The spacious and air-conditioned Laughlin Center boasts three full-size basketball courts and four volleyball courts, training room, four locker rooms, restrooms, and a concession stand. The Laughlin Center also houses the college fitness center.

**DORMS**

Every camper will share an air conditioned dorm room with another camper for the week. All rooms have two beds, desks, dressers, and closets. Dorm lobbies feature televisions, pool tables and ping pong.

**All camps begin with registration from 5:30-6:30 p.m. and end with awards at Noon on the last day. After application is received, a confirmation letter will be sent with more information regarding registration locations.**

**BOYS' AND GIRLS' SOCCER - JUNE 24-27**

The LCU Soccer Camp offers a full range of instruction for campers in grades 6-12. Camp will include basic techniques and fitness, one-on-one play, passing, finishing, and advanced tactics covering all positions on the field including goalkeeper. Along with the daily drill and skill, each camper will be placed on a team personally instructed by an LCU camp staff member. Campers will play on an indoor team for camp in the evenings in addition to the outdoor activities. Every camper will also have interaction time with coaches and players who will share their passion for the Lord and their love of soccer. This camp is designed to help players grow their skills for soccer, for life, and for serving Christ.

### WHAT IS A RED LION?

Seeking a mascot that would embody all these truths together with Earl Hargrove's vision of the mission of LCU, to prepare preachers and other leaders for service in the church and the world, was a task that was not undertaken lightly. After much careful consideration and prayerful discussion, Lincoln Christian University announced the new Athletics mascot...the Red Lions.

The lion has been viewed positively throughout much of human history, often referred to as "king of the jungle," or "king of beasts." It has been a prominent symbol in ancient art and architecture. The Bible uses the lion metaphorically to describe the Tribe of Judah as a people marked with boldness, power, and majesty. Scripture also uses lion imagery to offer a fascinating contrast between Satan and Jesus. Satan is presented as a treacherous lion looking to devour (1 Peter 5:8), while Jesus is pictured as a triumphant lion who makes everything right (Revelation 5:5). Our enemy, like a hungry lion, is ruthless and aggressive, but our Lord, as an honored lion, is majestic and worshiped in the end like the victorious Aslan of C.S. Lewis' Chronicles of Narnia. As a mascot for LCU, the lion represents an athletic program marked with dignity, discipline, and an eager desire to delight in the One who alone satisfies (Job 38:39 and Psalm 104:21)."
